DID YOU KNOW ...

Autism comes with unique talents and unique challenges.

 Children with autism can have exceptional memory, attention to detail, academic and artistic talents. But they are also more likely to experience loneliness than other children.

Early identification is linked to better long-term outcomes.

 In Wisconsin, the majority of kids with autism are diagnosed by 4 years of age. Early identification allows caregivers and educators to tailor experiences and environments to the child's needs.
